



Privacy Policy

Your privacy is crucial to us. Accordingly, we have developed this Policy for you to understand how we collect, use, communicate, disclose, and make use of personal information.

1. Personal Data

1. The primary purpose of personal data processing by the Administrator (Michał Załęcki; Kołobrzaska 16/3, 85-704 Bydgoszcz, Poland; VAT ID: PL5542966629) is to enable the User to purchase the Ebook through the Website [michalzalecki.com].

2. In order to purchase the Ebook PDF file (Ethereum: 30 Tips & Tricks For Solidity Developers), you must complete a form that requires the e-mail address, contact details, and credit card/payment details.

3. The Administrator processes the following personal data: name, surname, address, e-mail address, IP.

4. Providing personal data required by the Administrator during registration is necessary to conclude an agreement on purchasing the Ebook

5. No external entities, independent of the Administrator, will have access to the data provided by the User unless they perform work ordered by the Administrator that requires access to Users' personal data.

6. Personal data is processed only by persons authorized by the Administrator.

7. The Service Provider reserves the right to process the Buyer's data after termination of the Agreement or withdrawal of consent only in the scope of seeking possible claims before the court or if national or EU regulations or international law oblige us to retain data.

8. Every data subject has the right of access to data, rectification, deletion or limitation of processing, the right to object, the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory organization.

9. The Administrator will allow the User full access to his personal data, their modification, supplementation, suspension of processing or deletion.

2. Cookies
